Today your child received a visit from me, Sparkles the Fire Safety Dog, or from one or both of my fire safety dog friends, as well as from Firefighter Dayna.

The program included your child/ren meeting a real fire safety dog, a partial reading of one of Firefighter Dayna's children's fire safety books (credited with helping save the lives of two children and their two families), the singing of fire safety songs and the administration of the Jr. Firefighter Oath. The time also included a question and answer session.

They learned the following very important fire safety messages:

1. Recognizing the firefighter as a helper and a friend
2. Knowing the sound and purpose of a smoke alarm
3. Understanding the importance of practicing a home fire drill using an escape map
4. Knowing when and how to crawl low under smoke

We had a lot of fun, but we need your help! Attached you will find a copy of an escape map. Please fill out the escape map with your child/ren and practice your home fire drill at least twice a year.
